OTHER INFORMATION:

- **UNEMP BENEFITS:** The state is continuing to process unemployment benefits for individuals who had 'employee' status and pandemic unemployment assistance for individuals who had 'independent contractor' status. Unemployment down to 9.5%
- **DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH RECCOMENDATION REGARDING FACE COVERINGS:** Face coverings should be worn in all indoor and outdoor settings where you are exposed to non-household members and you cannot maintain a distance of 6 feet. Should cover both the mouth and the nose.
- **STATE/ NATIONAL PARKS:** State Parks are fully opened and available for overnight visitors. Check the State Parks [website](#) for a full list of trails and parks.
- **PUBLIC /SOCIAL GATHERINGS:** Guidance is to continue to observe social distancing, wearing masks, and frequent handwashing.
- **RESTAURANTS AND BARS:** Restaurants and bars in the state are allowed to operate with a maximum of 1/3 capacity for dine-in customers.
